## NLC-UPDATE

FCCLA National Leadership Conference was held July 2-6 in Denver, Colorado. Missouri was represented by 347 members, advisers, and guests from 73 chapters, and had 183 members competing in competitive events.

Missouri FCCLA received recognition for increased membership (up 14% over last year!), Nodaway-Holt won a \$500 prize for being the State FACTS winner, Campbell FCCLA took 2nd place in the National FCCLA LifeSmarts Knowledge Bowl, and Clarkton FCCLA took 3rd place in the National FCCLA LifeSmarts Knowledge Bowl.

In STAR Events, Missouri have 66 gold medals and 96 silver medals with 39 top-ten finishing teams, and 9 top-three finishing teams!
