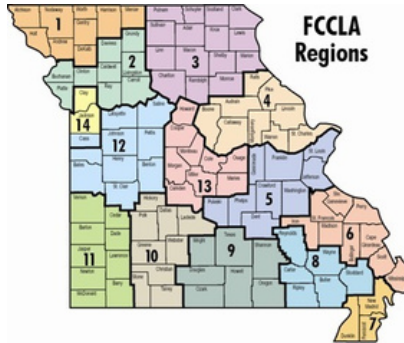


BUILDING STRONG LEADERS
