

## BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Directors shall consist of members from a diverse spectrum of stakeholders that may include chapter advisers, business and industry representatives, educators, school administrators, and youth members. The board shall be composed of no more than thirteen members.

Members Ex-Officio – There shall be five members ex-officio of the Board of Directors, as follows:

- 1. State Executive Council President
- 2. Local adviser to the State Executive Council President
- 3. One representative of the executive board of the Missouri Educators of Family Consumer Sciences
- 4. Director of the Family Consumer Sciences and Human Services Cluster within the DESE Office of College and Career Readiness
- 5. State Adviser

<u>Youth Members</u> – In addition to the current President of the State Executive Council, there shall be two youth members, as follows:

- 1. Most recent Past President of the State Executive Council
- 2. State Executive Council Vice President of Finance

Members At-Large – There shall be six members at-large elected by the Board of Directors, as follows:

- 1. Two business and industry representatives
- 2. One post-secondary educator, with preference for those in Family Consumer Science education or a related field
- 3. One secondary school administrator
- 4. Three local chapter advisers (in addition to the adviser to the State Executive Council President) elected by the local advisers attending the State Leadership Conference

Members at-large shall serve a term of two years. Such directors may be reelected for a second two-year term. At least 12 months must have elapsed before any such director having served two consecutive terms may be elected for another term. The board chairperson and State Executive Council president shall each serve one year following their terms of office. Other members ex-officio shall serve on the board until the time they vacate their respective office.
