Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) is a nonprofit national Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) for young men and women in Family and Consumer Sciences (FCS) education programs in public and private schools through grade 12. Everyone is part of a family, and FCCLA is the only national CTSO with the family as its central focus. Since 1945, FCCLA members have been making a difference in their families, careers, and communities by addressing important personal, work, and societal issues through Family and Consumer Sciences education.

Missouri Association Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) was chartered in 1946 and has consistently maintained its status as one of the **top ten state associations** within the national organization of more than 46 states, the District of Columbia, the American Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico.

Today, **more than 9000 student members and more than 4000 adult advisers are active in more than 300 chapters across Missouri**. The work of FCCLA helps students and teachers focus on a variety of youth concerns, including parenting, family relationships, substance abuse, peer pressure, sustainability, nutrition and fitness, teen violence, and career preparation in four specific career pathways. Involvement in FCCLA offers members the opportunity to expand their leadership potential and develop skills for life -- planning, goal setting, problem solving, decision making, and interpersonal communication -- necessary in the home and workplace.

The 2025 National Leadership Conference will be in Orlando, Florida. The National Leadership Conference Scholarship fully funds one member's experience at NLC in Orlando, including conference registration, transportation to and from Orlando plus local transportation as needed while in Orlando, lodging, all meals, and \$50 credit at the FCCLA Store. Scholarship sponsors can specify the student to whom they'd like to award the scholarship, or can choose to award the scholarship to a student that has applied through Missouri FCCLA.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP | CHOICE CONTRIBUTION
