

**LEGISLATIVE SHADOWING PROJECT 2026**  
**CODE OF CONDUCT & DRESS CODE**  
**April 21-22 , 2026**

The Missouri Association Family, Career and Community Leaders of America requires each Legislative Shadowing Project to read, complete and upload this form with their online application by February 1, 2026 to the Missouri FCCLA website.

1. Participants will be required to wear the official FCCLA blazer with black pants/skirt and dress shoes on the day of shadowing. Participants and advisers/chaperones should follow the Missouri FCCLA Conference Attire Dress Code for both days as well.
2. Participant conduct at all times should be such that it reflects credit on the student, school and state association. Student conduct is the responsibility of the local chapter adviser or designated chaperone.
3. Any damages to any property or furnishing in hotel rooms, meeting rooms or conference locations must be paid by the individual responsible and may subject the individual to criminal prosecution, and will be sent home at the individual's expense.
4. Participants are to report any accidents, injuries, or illness to their local chapter adviser, designated chaperone or state adviser immediately.
5. Participants shall be prompt and prepared for all activities.
6. Participants must be in their sleeping rooms and quiet at the published curfew of 11 p.m.
7. No tobacco, vaping, e-cigarette products, alcoholic beverages or other illegal substances in any form shall be possessed at any time, under any circumstances, while representing the local school and Family, Career and Community Leaders of America.
8. Once in attendance at this FCCLA activity, participants will not leave the premises without their adviser or other designated chaperone.
9. Male and female participants may not be in the same sleeping room unless the door is open and an adviser/chaperone is present in the room.
10. Participants will do thank-you's as well as project activities by deadlines set.
11. Violation of the above may result in being sent home at your own expense, referral to the appropriate authorities, or other action deemed appropriate by the chapter adviser, school administration or state FCCLA adviser.
